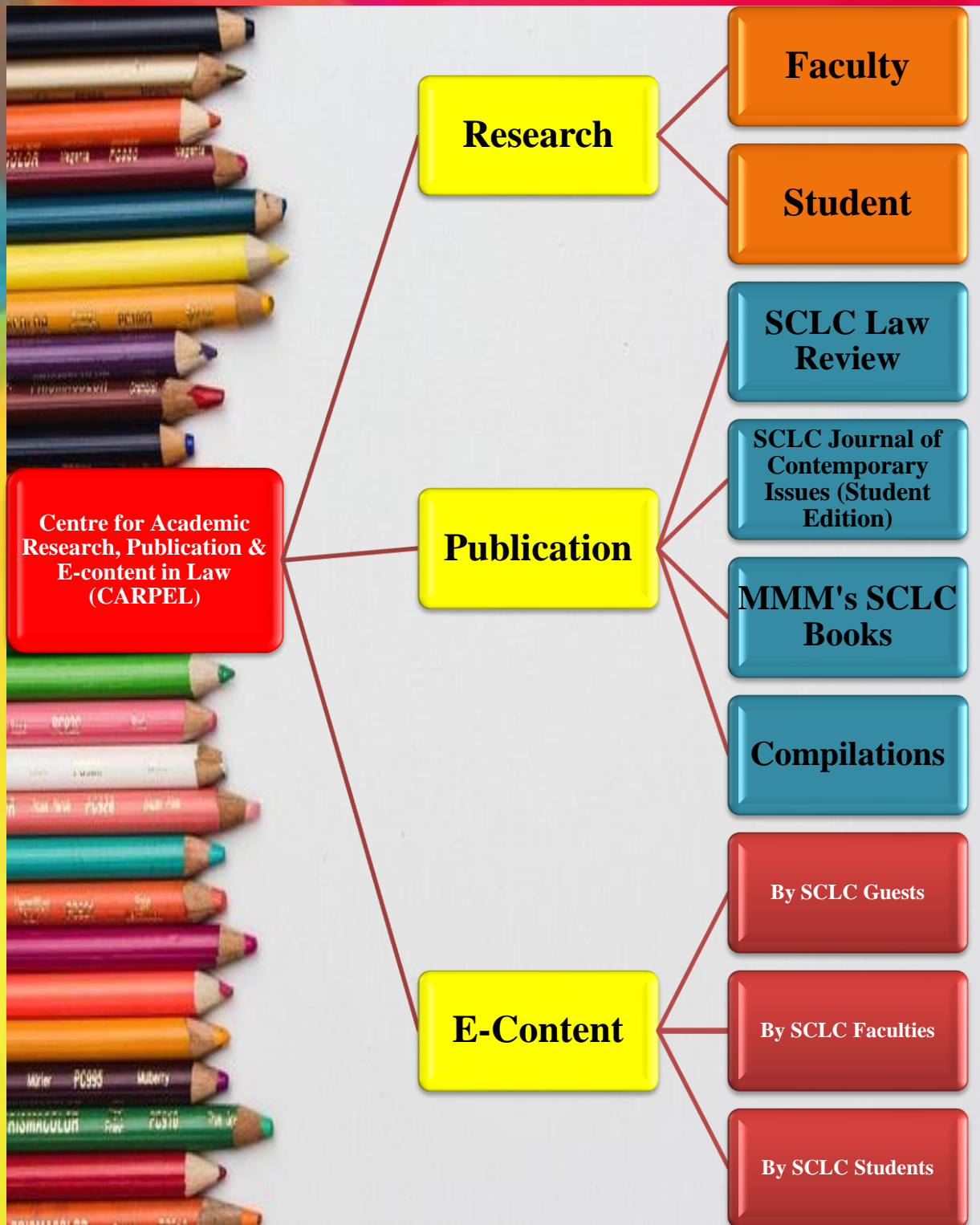

Marathwada Mitra Mandal's Shankarrao Chavan Law College, Pune in Collaboration with The Centre for the Study of Human Rights (CSHR) And The Faculty of Law, University of Colombo, Colombo (SRI LANKA) organised International Conference on "Legal Dimensions of Human Rights in the Technological Realm" on 17<sup>th</sup> - 18<sup>th</sup> January, 2020 at Marathwada Mitra Mandal's Shankarrao Chavan Law College, Pune.
