To sensitize students about the human rights values and to inculcate among them respect for them, every year college celebrates Human Rights Week. In the academic year 2020-2021, the Cell for Human Rights Activities ( C.H.R.A) celebrated this week from 30<sup>th</sup> March to 3<sup>rd</sup> April, 2021. Due to pandemic caused by covid-19, all activities were conducted through online mode. Dr. Bhagwan Gawali, Ms. Revati Naik and Ms. Krushna Badade were the faculty in charge of the event. There was overwhelming response of students for these activities. Following is the list of events conducted during Human Rights Week:-

- **Guest Lecture on ‘Impact of Judicial Pronouncements on Human Rights of women and children-** Adv. Rama Sarode, eminent social activist, addressed the gathering of students on the above mentioned topic. She analysed all important judicial pronouncements which has exercised substantial influence over the law regarding human rights relating to women and children. The lecture concluded with interactive session. This lecture was organized 1<sup>st</sup> April, 2020 from 11.00 to 12.30. The feedback received from the students about the lecture was satisfactory.
- **Human Rights Awareness Quiz-** To create awareness among students about the Human Rights the Awareness Quiz was conducted on 2<sup>nd</sup> April, 2021 from 1.00p.m. to 3.00 p.m. It received overwhelming response from students and as many as 126 students attempted the Quiz and scored good marks.
- **Students presentation on Human Rights-** On 3<sup>rd</sup> April, 2021, students gave presentation through videos, ppts on various topics relating to Human Rights. These presentations were on the vast category of subjects such as

rights of women, children, refugees and minority communities. They also included the role of law in addressing the plight of vulnerable and underprivileged persons.

- **Visit to Non Governmental Organisation:-** In order to extend our helping hands to deprived persons, like every year, faculties of the college visited the non governmental organisation. This year the visit was made to Eklayva Prathistan, Pune runned by Hon'ble Renutai Gavaskar. Stduents, faculties and college contributed and more than 9,000 rupees were donated to this N.G.O.
