WORKSHOP ON DEBATING SKILLS- 3RD NOVEMBER, 2023

Date: 5th Nov., 2023

- **Introduction**

The debating Skills workshop, conducted by Adv. Ankit Mishra was organized by Socrates Society for Debate and Elocution on November 3, 2023, was a comprehensive exploration of effective Debating and Elocution skills. The session aimed to cultivate an understanding that speaking is not merely a skill but an art, emphasizing the importance of passion and authenticity in debating and in communication. **107 students successfully participated in the workshop.**

- **Setting the Stage**

Commencing with a thought-provoking video, "How to Speak So That People Want to Listen?" by Julian Treasure, the workshop delved into the 7 deadly sins of speaking: Gossip, Judging, Negativity, Lying, Embroidery, Exaggeration, and Dogmatism. The principles of HAIL—Honesty, Authenticity, Integrity, and Love—were introduced, providing a holistic approach to effective communication.

- **Toolbox for Speaking Skills**

Adv. Ankit Mishra shared a practical toolbox for refining speaking skills, encompassing elements such as register, timbre, prosody, pace, pitch, and volume. This approach aimed to foster a conscious and deliberate method of creating sound, moving beyond casual speech.

- **Practical Exercises**

The session included engaging exercises, notably the word introduction activity.



Participants creatively utilised words like Blue, Russian, Music, Blossom, and Objects, followed by constructive feedback from Adv. Ankit Mishra. This practical component added a dynamic dimension to the learning experience.

- **Debating Strategies**

Adv. Ankit Mishra extended the discourse to debating, exploring the concept of positional advantage for both first and second speakers. Strategies for capitalising on opportunities and understanding judges' dynamics were highlighted, providing valuable insights into the nuances of effective debating.



- **Interactive Games**

The workshop incorporated interactive games, such as spontaneous sentence creation, adding an element of unpredictability and enhancing participants' adaptability in communication.

- **Sequential Development of Skills**

The importance of sequential development of Listening, Reading, Speaking, and Writing skills was underscored. Adv. Ankit Mishra emphasised how these skills contribute to sentence structure and thought translation, providing a foundation for effective communication.



- **Debating Components**

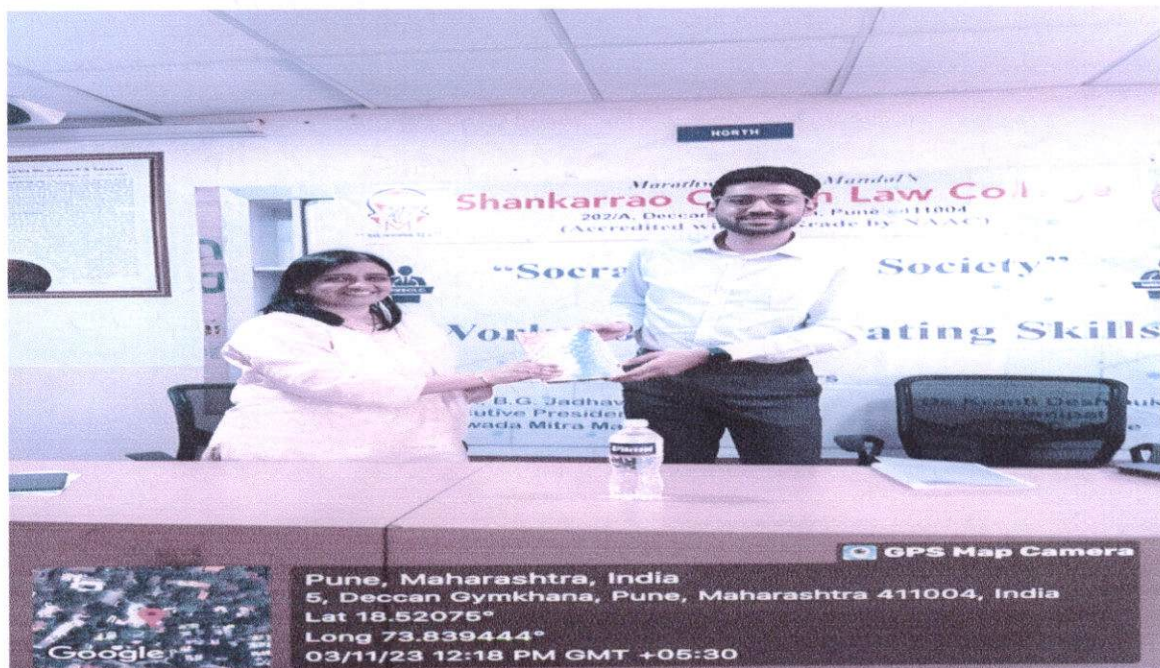

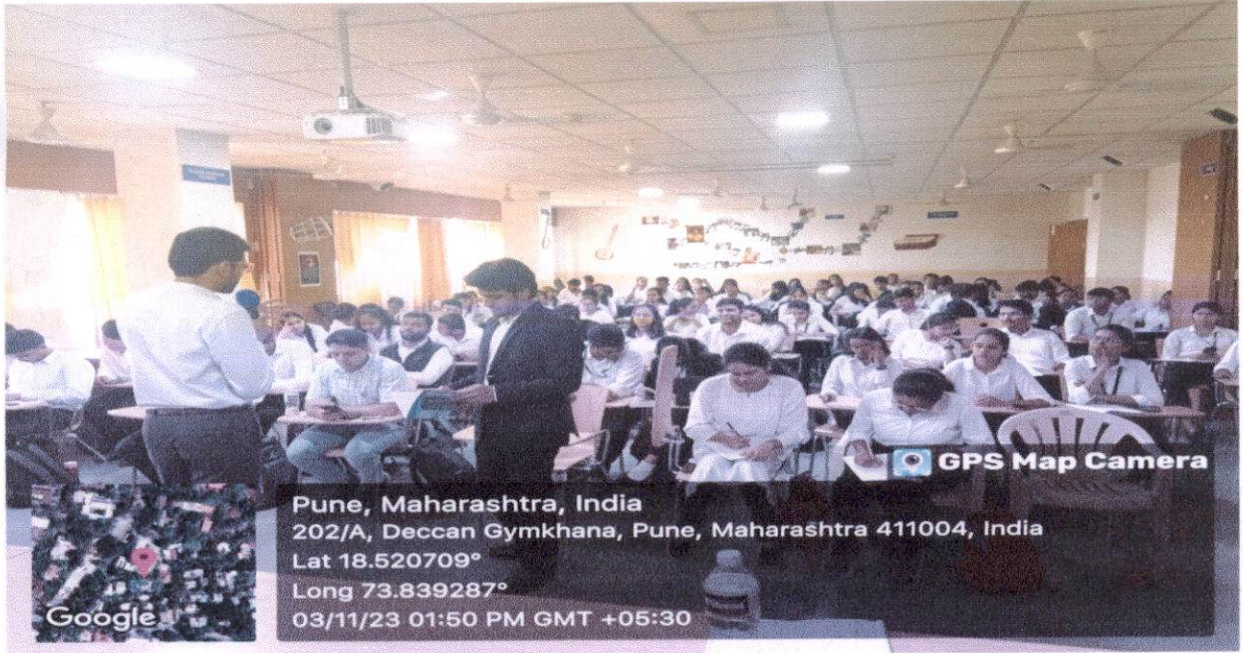
- **Final Speech and Practical Tips**

- **Conclusion**

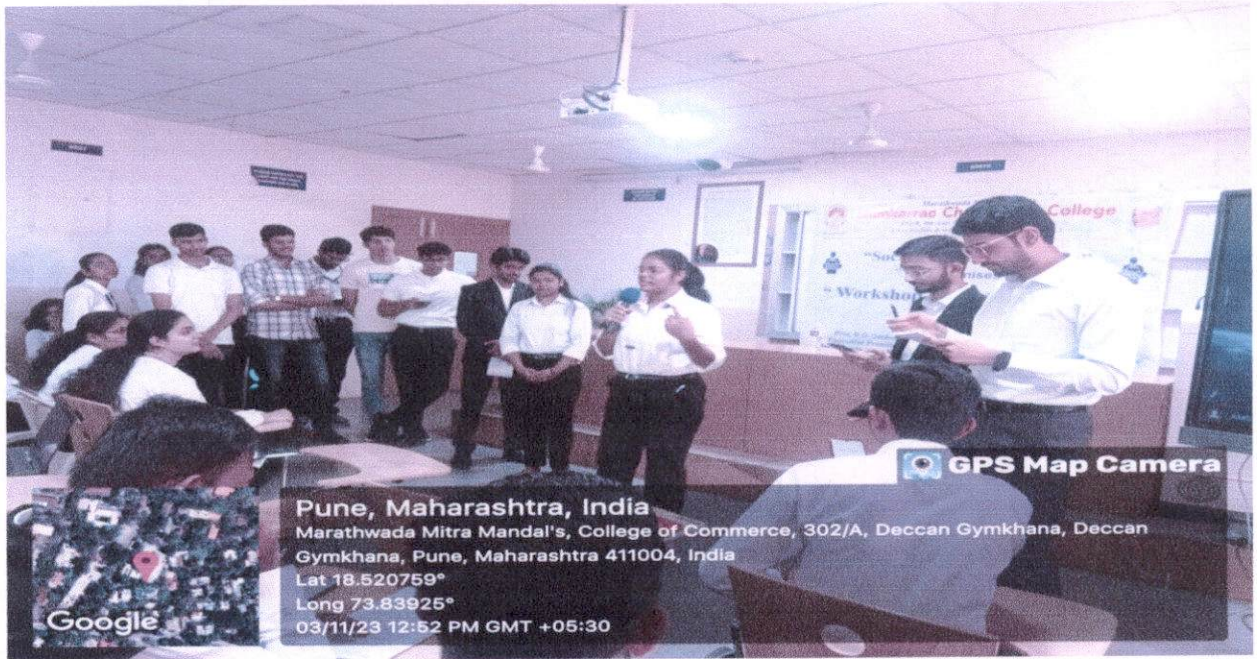

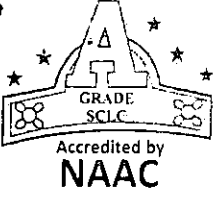

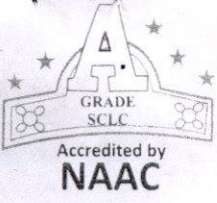
