Annual Report of the Academic Year 2021-22

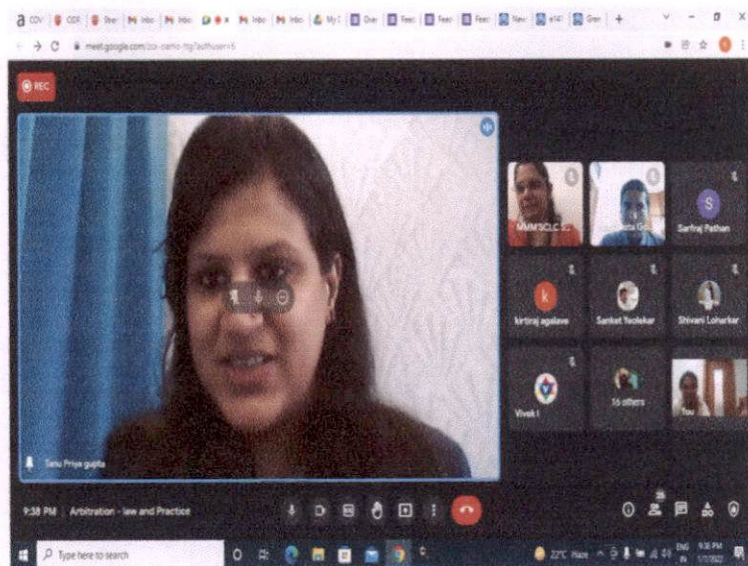

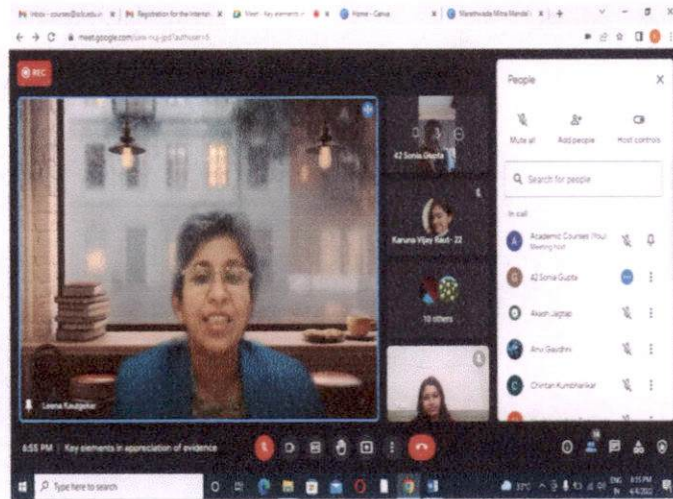

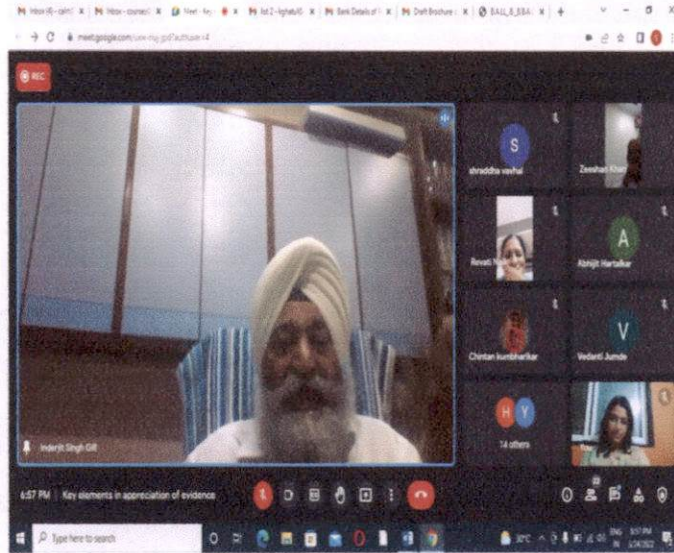
