The 12thLate. Shri ShankarraoChavan State level Elocution competition was organized on 21st September 2019. In this event total 40 participants took part from different areas of Maharashtra. Hon'ble Mr.Justice Manish Pitale , Judge High Court of Bombay (Nagpur Bench) was the chief guest of the Inaugural function . In his speech he emphasizedon the importance of elocution for an advocate. He also appreciated the efforts of the committee responsible for the selection of subjects for the elocution competition. Topics for elocution were-
