g. Brief about program

The Centre for Law, Public Policy and Governance organized the 3rd edition of the Hon'ble Shri Shankarrao Chavan National Legislative Drafting Competition. This annual event pays tribute to the memory of Hon'ble Shri Shankarrao Chavan, the founder of Marathwada Mitra Mandal. The competition aims to



promote legislative drafting skills among law students across the country. The detailed brochure for the competition was released on December 19, 2022, and participants were given until February 10, 2023, to submit their draft bills.

A total of 28 participants from various law institutions took part in the competition. The participants showcased their expertise in legislative drafting, displaying their knowledge of legal principles and their ability to draft effective and comprehensive bills.

The results of the competition were announced during an online program held on February 25, 2023. The winners were selected based on the quality and effectiveness of their draft bills. The institutions representing the top three winners were:

1. First Prize: University of Rajasthan, S.S. Jain Subodh Law College, Jaipur

- **Prize: Rs. 7000/- and e-certificate**

2. Second Prize: Marathwada Mitra Mandal Shankarrao Chavan Law College, Pune

- **Prize: Rs. 5000/- and e-certificate**

3. Third Prize: The Tamilnadu Dr. Ambedkar Law University

- **Prize: Rs. 3000/- and e-certificate**

The winners demonstrated exceptional skills in legislative drafting, showcasing their ability to construct well-structured and comprehensive bills that address legal issues effectively.

The competition not only provided participants with an opportunity to enhance their legislative drafting skills but also recognized their efforts and achievements through monetary prizes and e-certificates.


- Eligibility - UG Students of any stream.

- Font: Times New Roman, size: 12, line spacing: 1.5, Page Margins: 1" from all four sides, page numbers: bottom right corner.
- Mention Name, address, and contact number of institution and participants on first page. Participants shall also mention their year of studying in 2022-23.

- Last Date for Submission - 10th February, 2023 (08:59 p.m.).
- Above mentioned title of the Bill is general in nature and can be reframed by participants.
- The length of the draft shall not exceed 20 pages.
- Participants may attach separate file for Explanation (if they wish to submit) not exceeding 5 pages.
- Evaluation is based on Structure, Logic, Addressing legal issues, Clarity and unambiguous writing style, Innovative ideas.
- Prizes - First Rs. 7000/-, Second Rs. 5000/-, Third Rs. 3000/-.
- Top 10 drafts will be published and will be forwarded to appropriate authorities.
- All participants will get e-certificate of participation.
- Declaration of Result - Online Program - 26th February, 2023.


