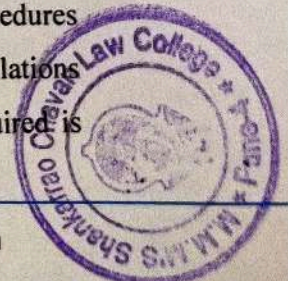
SUBJECT: PAVING WAY INTO THE LEGAL CORPORATE WORLD

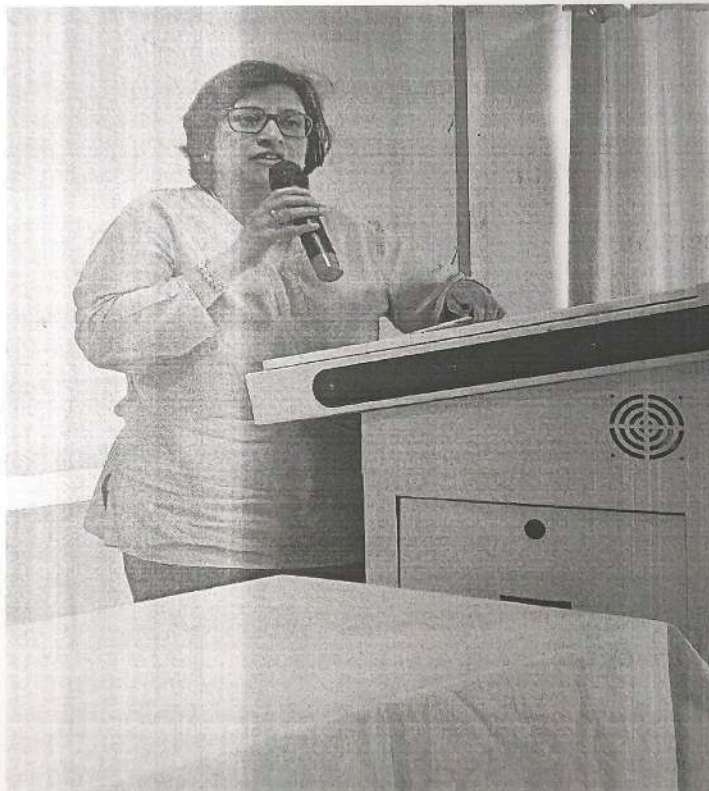




