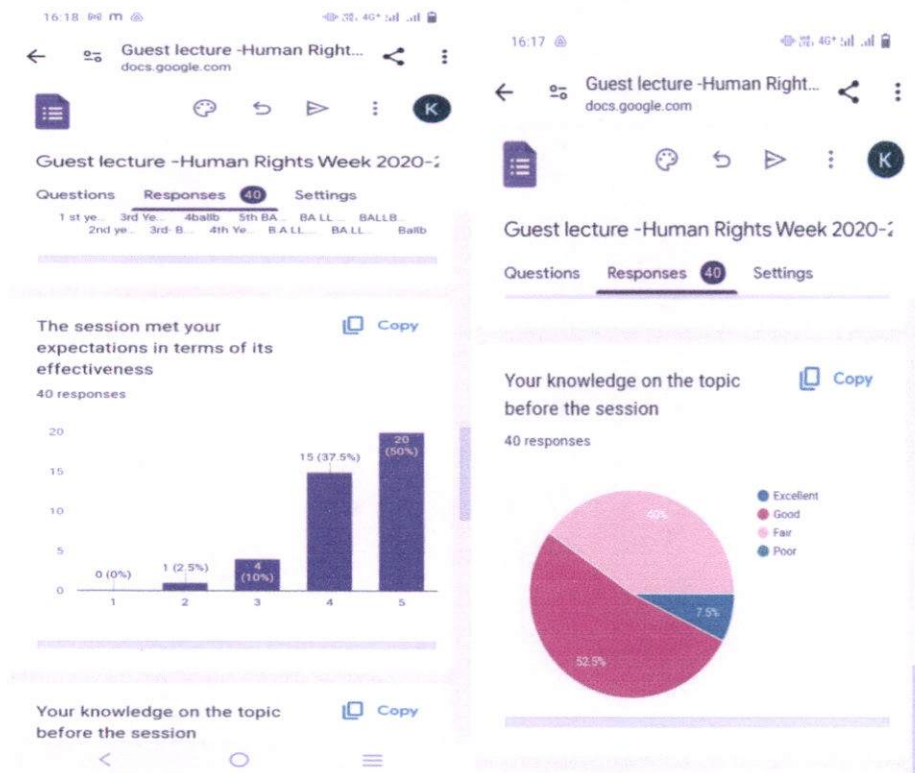

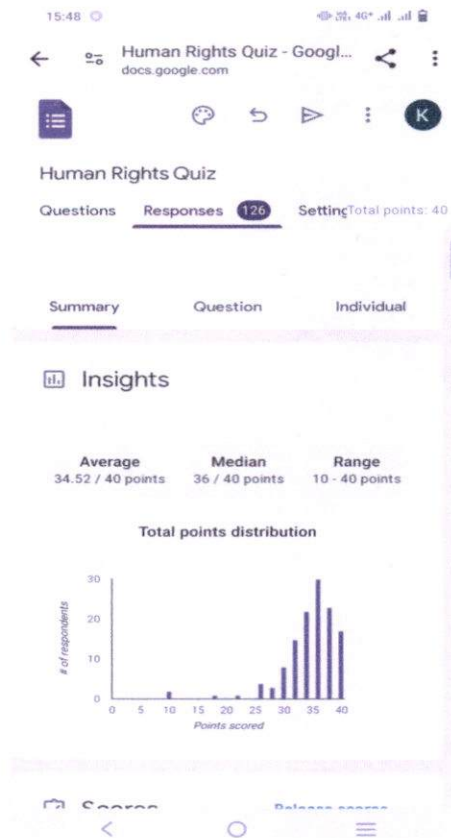

The Human Rights Week celebration conducted through online mode became successful in imparting human rights education to students.




