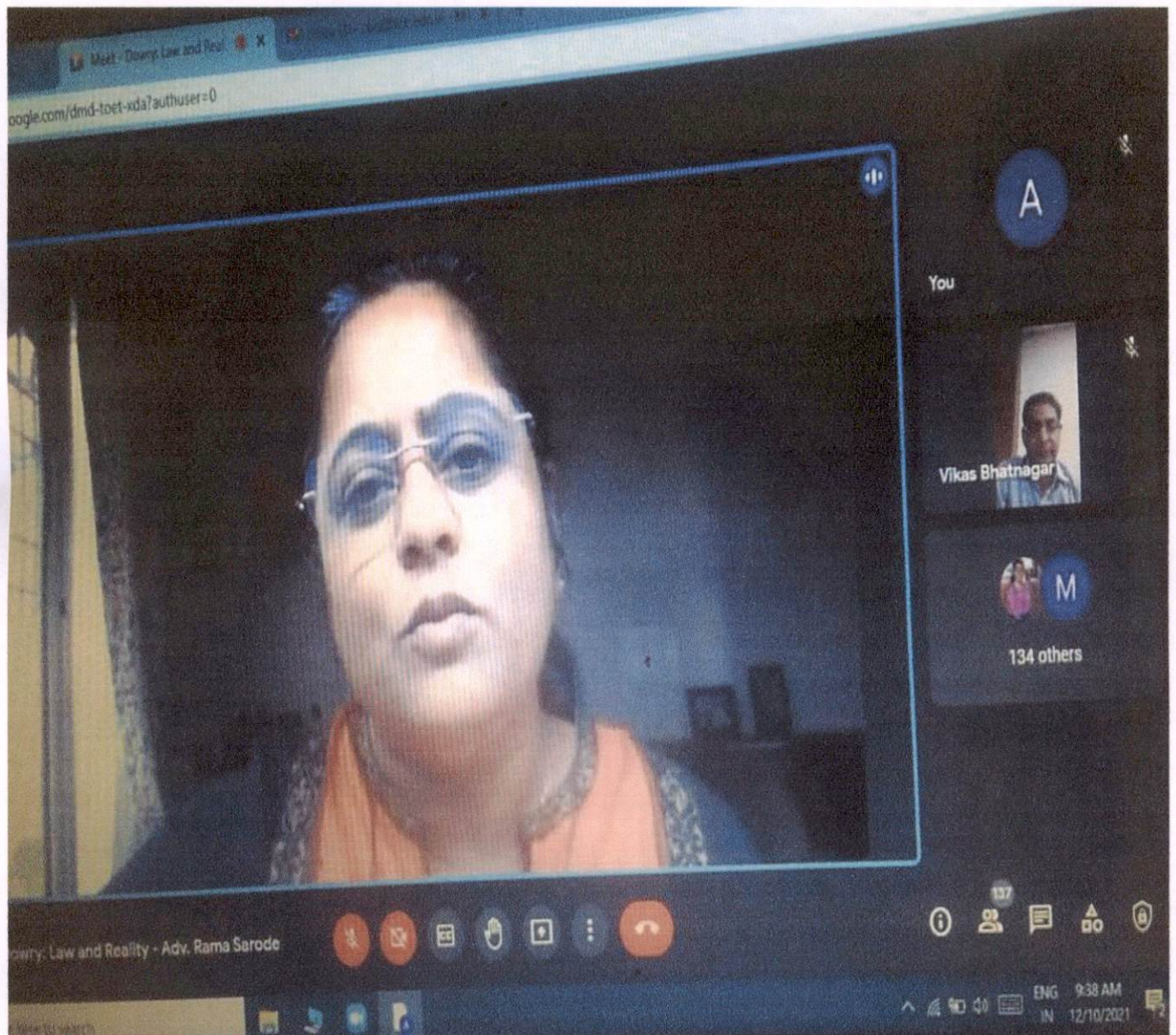
b. Object of the activity and beneficiaries:

- To address and find solutions for deep-rooted forms of discrimination that have affected the most vulnerable peoples in societies, including women, indigenous groups, migrants, people with disabilities, among others;
- To sensitise students and make them aware about human right violations of diverse groups.

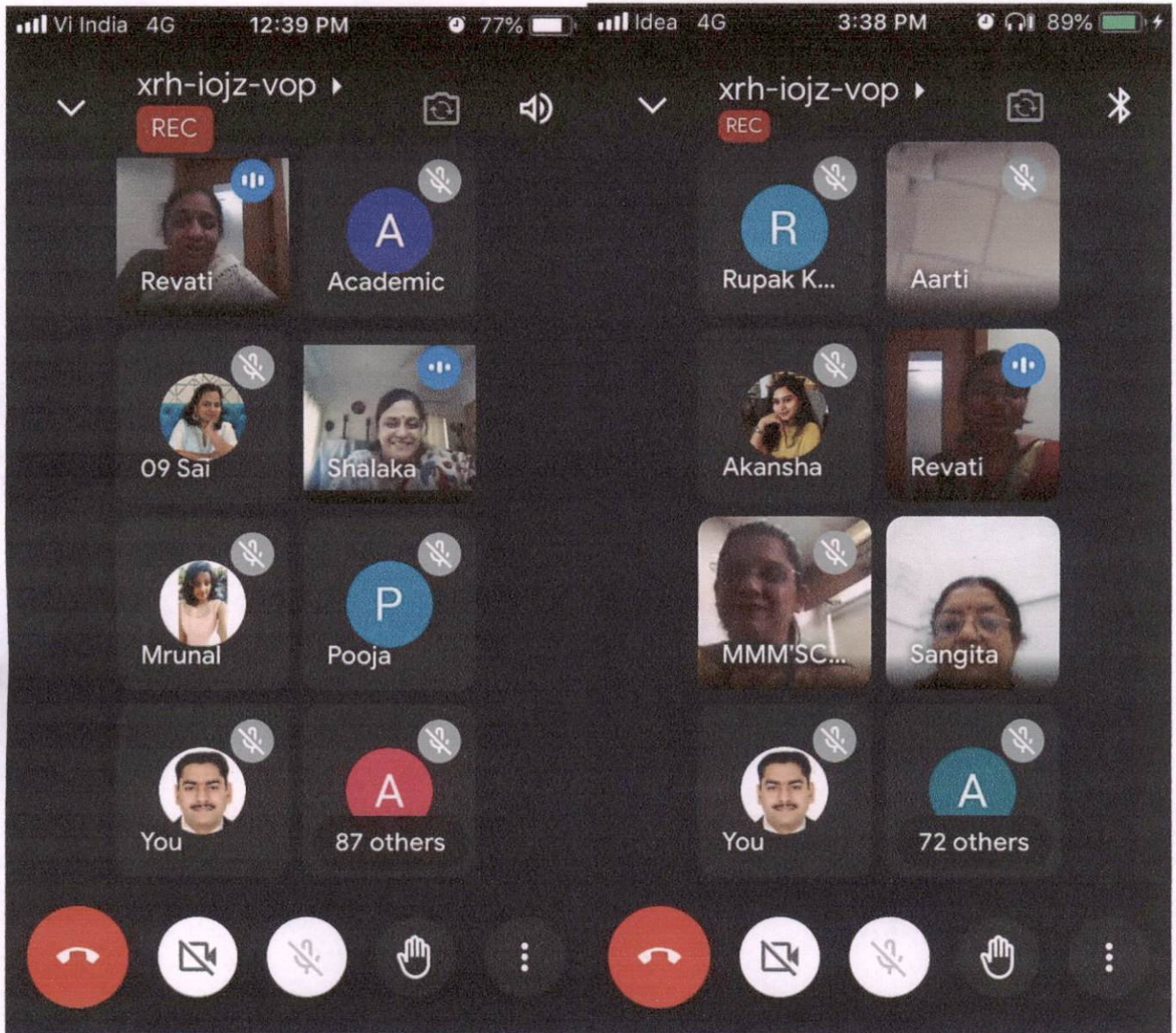
c. Details of the activity:

To mark the adoption of the historic document of Universal Declaration of Human Rights (UDHR) dated 10th December, 1948, Marathwada Mitra Mandal's Shankarrao Chavan Law College through its Cell for Human Rights Activities, Pune organised six day-long activities in lieu of Human Rights Week from 10th December, 2021 to 16th December, 2021 in an hybrid mode (GoogleMeet Platform).

- On 10.12.2021, Adv. Rama Sarode, Socio-Legal Trainer, Secretary - [SAHYOG](#) and Director - [MYGROWTHZONE](#) graced the programme with her virtual presence and addressed all participants on the topic, 'Dowry: Law and Reality'. It was followed by a Q&A session that covered many diverse perspectives. A total of 199 participants sought this unique opportunity to deepen their insights towards this social menace of dowry. Dr. Revati Naik. Prof. Gajendra Dhamal and Asst. Prof. Uroosa Naireen S. were the coordinators for this activity.

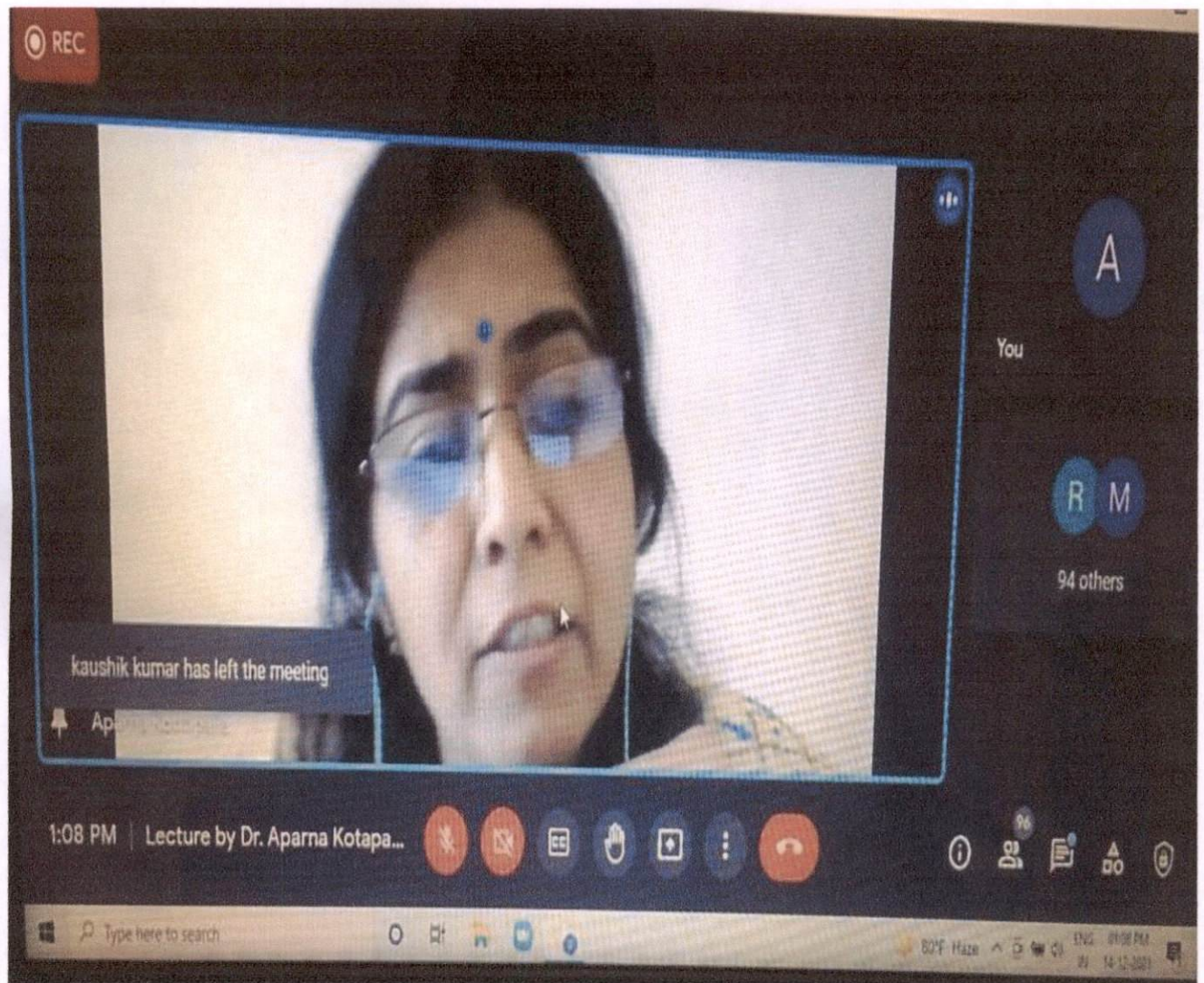

g. Brief about program

To mark 73rd anniversary of adoption of UDHR, 1948, Cell for Human Rights Activities made a successful attempt in sensitizing students and faculty alike by organising an activity-filled Human Rights Week so as to reduce inequalities and discrimination and to pave the way for equality, inclusion and sustainability. Adv. Rama Sarode, Dr. Kotapalle, Dr. VS Elizabeth, Dr. Sangita Laha, Dr. Asha Verma, Dr. Shalaka Shimpi, Prof. Dr. Manika Kamthan gave a detailed brief on the aspects revolving around human rights of women.

h. Feedback Details

Speaker 1: Adv. Rama Sarode - 124 students sent their feedback.

More than 23% of students answered positively stating that 75% of the information provided by the lecture was new to them; 74% students are eager to learn more about the topic; Students rated the speaker on the following factors:

- speaker's knowledge regarding the topic on the scale of 86/100,

- speaker's content on the scale of 87/100,
- speaker's time management on the scale of 86/100,
- speaker's presentation skills on the scale of 79/80

Students rated the session on the following factors:

- session fared well when compared to student's expectations: 79/80
- overall session evaluation: 86/100
- overall experience: 87/100

Speaker 2: Dr. Aparna Kotapalle - 110 students sent their feedback.

More than 22% of students answered positively stating that 75% of the information provided by the lecture was new to them; 73% students are eager to learn more about the topic;

Students rated the speaker on the following factors:

- speaker's knowledge regarding the topic on the scale of 80/80,
- speaker's content on the scale of 80/100,
- speaker's time management on the scale of 77/80,
- speaker's presentation skills on the scale of 78/80

Students rated the session on the following factors:

- session fared well when compared to student's expectations: 83/100
- overall session evaluation: 82/100
- overall experience: 80/80

Speakers: A National Seminar on Legal Regime relating to Reproductive Rights of Indian Women and Social Reality

More than 60 % of students rated the overall feedback of the seminar as satisfactory.
