By fostering structured debate, diplomacy, and dialogue, the MM SCLC Youth Summit aims to cultivate critical thinking, leadership skills, and a deep sense of civic responsibility. The initiative seeks to empower the youth to contribute thoughtfully to democratic discourse and global problem-solving, thereby shaping socially conscious individuals committed to building a just and inclusive future.

## Youth Parliament (YP)

Youth Parliament is an experiential learning simulation that mirrors the procedures, functioning, and spirit of a parliamentary democracy. It provides participants with a practical understanding of legislative processes, policy formulation, and democratic governance, while encouraging them to deliberate on pressing national and social issues. Through structured debates, question hours, and policy discussions, the Youth Parliament enables students to develop oratory skills, critical reasoning, leadership qualities, and constitutional awareness, fostering respect for democratic institutions and the rule of law.

## Model United Nations (MUN)

Model United Nations (MUN) is an academic simulation of the United Nations that offers participants an opportunity to step into the roles of diplomats representing different countries. Delegates engage in informed discussions on contemporary global challenges, including international peace and security, human rights, climate change, sustainable development, and economic cooperation.

By participating in negotiations, drafting resolutions, and engaging in diplomatic dialogue, students develop skills in research, negotiation, public speaking, and consensus-building, while gaining a deeper understanding of international law, multilateral diplomacy, and global governance.

## Youth Parliament Committees

The Youth Parliament segment of the MMSCLC Youth Summit offers participants an immersive simulation of India's democratic institutions, enabling them to engage directly with legislative procedures, policy debates, and governance challenges. The committees being simulated under the Youth Parliament segment of the summit are:

1. Lok Sabha
2. Maharashtra Legislative Assembly (Vidhan Sabha)

## Lok Sabha

Lok Sabha, the House of the People, represents the primary legislative body of the Indian Parliament. In this committee, participants assume the roles of Members of Parliament and deliberate on pressing issues of national importance. The simulation focuses on law-making, public policy formulation, executive accountability, and democratic debate, fostering a practical understanding of parliamentary procedures, constitutional responsibilities, and representative governance.

### Agenda

Discussion on Electoral Integrity and Democratic Reforms and an assessment of Illegal immigration, with Special Reference to the implementation of Special Intensive Revision (SIR).

This committee enables participants to engage with state-specific legislative, administrative, and socio-economic issues, highlighting the role of state governments in India's federal structure. Through structured debates and discussions, delegates gain insights into state legislation, governance mechanisms, and centre-state relations, while developing skills in advocacy, negotiation, and policy analysis.

### Agenda

Discussion on the farmer suicide with respect to price parity and sustainable livelihoods in Maharashtra's Agricultural landscape from a legislative and policymaking perspective and understanding the difficulties in agriculture sector.

## United Nations Human Rights Council (UNHRC)

The United Nations Human Rights Council (UNHRC) is the principal United Nations body responsible for the promotion and protection of human rights worldwide. Comprising member states elected by the UN General Assembly, the Council examines human rights situations, addresses violations, and formulates recommendations through resolutions, special procedures, and review mechanisms such as the Universal Periodic Review (UPR). This committee encourages delegates to critically engage with issues related to human rights protection, state accountability, international humanitarian norms, and enforcement challenges, while fostering informed dialogue grounded in international human rights law.

## United Nations Security Council (UNSC)

The United Nations Security Council (UNSC) is the primary organ of the United Nations entrusted with the responsibility of maintaining international peace and security. It consists of 15 members, including five permanent members (P5) with veto power and ten non-permanent members elected by the General Assembly for two-year terms. Delegates in this committee deliberate on complex global security issues involving armed conflicts, threats to peace, peacekeeping operations, sanctions, and diplomatic interventions, requiring high levels of strategic thinking, negotiation, and consensus-building.

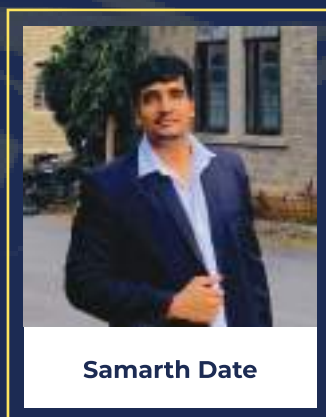
