VI. Significant Contributions made by IQAC during academic year 2025-26:

1. Induction Program 2025-26 – 23rd and 24th Sept., 2025

The College, in collaboration with the International Institute of Knowledge Management (TIKM), successfully organised an International Conference on Transformation, Resilience, Inclusion and Saving the Planet from 1st – 2nd Sept., 2025 at Bangkok, Thailand, in a hybrid mode. The Conference has stood out as a remarkable global gathering, uniting 750+ academics, researchers, scholars, industry professionals, and practitioners representing 18+ countries from various parts of the world. It featured parallel sessions enriched with diverse research findings, case studies, and interdisciplinary dialogue, while also offering numerous networking and publishing opportunities to further amplify the impact of participants' scholarly contributions.

4. International Conference on 'Human Rights in Armed Conflicts- Asian European Perspectives' - 6th - 7th Feb., 2026

The College organised an International Conference on Human Rights in Armed Conflict: Asian-European Perspectives, in collaboration with the Indo-European Education Foundation, Poland, with associate partners including University of Opole (Poland) and Hochschule Mittweida University of Applied Sciences (Germany) on 6th and 7th Feb., 2026. By bringing together Asian and European perspectives, it aimed to examine the interplay between Human Rights Law, Humanitarian Law, International Criminal Law, and Refugee Law in conflict situations, addressing gaps in implementation, and foster collaborative strategies to strengthen accountability, and the protection of civilians amid rapidly changing forms of warfare. It was attended by 200 participants, with fifty research papers presented.

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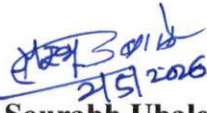
